Perception Glasses:

How We Perceive Life Becomes Our Reality!

We view all experiences, interactions, and conflicts through the lens of our own individual unique perception glasses.

Perception Glasses:

I am not meaning the eye glasses for our physical sight...

I am speaking about the metaphorical perception glasses through which we each individually view our lives and perceive the world around us.

Meaning of Perception:

The way in which something is regarded, understood, believed, or interpreted.

Perception is the conscious reception, selection, processing, and interpretation of information by our brain via our senses.

"The optimist sees the donut; the pessimist sees the hole!"
Oscar Wilde

Perception isn't something we often think about...

But our perception has a huge impact on our emotional state, our behaviour, our interactions and understanding of others, and also influences how we make decisions.

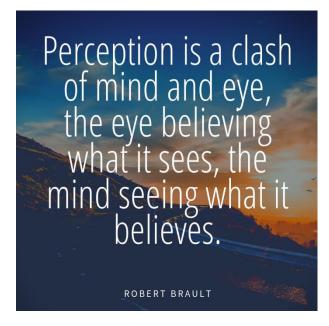
"Our attitudes, motivations, expectations, behaviour and interests are some of the factors affecting perception!"

Our perception acts as a lens through which we view reality:

Our perceptions influence what we focus on, process, remember, interpret, understand, synthesize, decide about, and act on, which ultimately determines our reality.

In doing so, our tendency is to falsely assume that how we perceive reality is an accurate representation of what reality truly is.

"Perception is a mirror not a fact! And what I look on is my state of mind, reflected outward!" Ralph Waldo Emerson



Biases:

Perception bias is a type of unconscious bias that occurs when our perception is skewed based on inaccurate and overly simplistic assumptions.

For example:

Biases, judgments, and assumptions about categories a person 'belongs' to...
These biases may include culture, race or stereotypes about age, gender, occupation, or appearance.

"Heredity, needs, peer group, upbringing, self worth, environment, interests, and expectations all influence our perception!"

Rashomon Effect:

Two people may witness the same event but have different perceptions based on their experiences, beliefs, expectations, and biases.

The term 'Rashomon Effect' represents the idea that individuals have conflicting interpretations of the same event or situation due to the influence of various factors such as cognitive biases, emotions, personal experiences, cultural backgrounds, and social norms.

"Nobody has an objective experience of reality as it's all through our own individual prisms!"

Crafting Unique Perspectives:

Imagine for a moment that we each wear a unique pair of glasses, crafted by our individual experiences, beliefs, attitudes, and biases.

These perception glasses act as filters, colouring our experiences, our interactions, and shaping the way we interpret and respond to the world.

"It's our perspective that determines how we interpret information, make judgments and take action!"

Embracing Diverse Perspectives:

Our lenses of perception construct our understanding of the world around us, resulting in a diverse array of perspectives that enrich the tapestry of humanity.

"The diversity of perspectives, stemming from our backgrounds, cultures, and belief systems, makes our world rich and vibrant!"

Unlimited Variety of Perception Glasses:

Every individual wear a unique pair of perception glasses...

Some have rose tinted glasses, seeing the positive side in everything, even amidst challenges.

Others wear sceptical glasses, seeking the truth, and viewing the world as an intriguing puzzle.

Some have kaleidoscope glasses, finding beauty in the ordinary and transforming the mundane into a magical vivid tapestry of colours.

A lot of people have glasses that magnified their difficulties, the injustice, or unsatisfactory conditions around them.

There are people wearing humour glasses, seeing the funny, lighter side of life.

Some wear polarized glasses, which divide their perceptions into binary oppositions. They create a world of black and white, right, and wrong, us and them.

Others have glasses of curiosity that embrace life as an opportunity for growth and self discovery.

Many are viewing the world through glasses of scarcity and limitation.

Our perception glasses also influence how we view life's purpose, whether as a divine masterpiece or a series of random events.

But no one's glasses of perception are the absolute truth!

Clouded Vision:

Just like foggy lenses hinder our vision, our perceptions can cloud our understanding, leading to difficulties, miscommunications, misunderstandings, conflicts, and division.



Expanding Your Perspective:

It's essential to question and challenge the assumptions embedded in your glasses of perception.

Are your glasses serving you well?

- Or limiting your potential?
- Or maybe preventing you from being open to new experiences and horizons?

Seek Expansion:

By actively seeking expansion, we can adjust, refine, or even discard our mental lenses to see beyond preconceived beliefs.

Clean and Connect:

Cleansing our mental lenses from biases and stereotypes allows us to appreciate the wonders of life and connect more deeply within ourselves, others, and the world.

By encompassing our other senses and intuition, we can extend our perception beyond what we see with our eyes or hear with our ears.

Interconnectedness:

By acknowledging the power of different perspectives, we can create an inclusive society where everyone's voice is heard and respected which can leads to us recognizing our interconnectedness.

By consciously choosing perception glasses that see the inherent beauty and potential in ourselves and others, we can create a positive ripple effect that transforms the world around us.
